BC'S COMMUNITY GAMING GRANT

The application dates for the capital project program have been adjusted for 2018, with eligible organizations having from June 1 to July 31, 2018, to submit applications.

Grants of up to \$250,000 are available, for 20% to 50% of the total project costs. The Community Gaming Grants branch will be hosting a webinar detailing the eligibility criteria for the capital projects sector on May 23, 2018. Registration details will be posted online in the coming weeks.
